I have always been a big fan of Advent! Oh, don't get me wrong; one look around the parish house, and you will know immediately that I also love Christmas, even with its many secular trappings! The truth is, a richer more abundant celebration of Advent will lead to an even richer and more abundant celebration of the Nativity of the Lord. But to achieve that wonderful end does take some work and reorienting ourselves in the coming weeks.

Over a decade ago, a few pastors were lamenting how they'd come to the end of an Advent season exhausted and sensing they'd *missed it* – the awe-inducing, soul-satisfying mystery of the Incarnation. They experienced how many of their parishioners struggled to find the connection between the "Christmas to-do lists" and the power of Jesus' birth. The time of year when focusing on Christ should be the easiest was often the hardest. Somehow, this had become the new normal.

So, in 2006, three pastors, Chris Seay, Greg Holder, and Rick McKinley, decided to try something different. They called it *the Advent Conspiracy movement*, and came up with four tenets—Worship Fully, Spend Less, Give More, Love All—to guide themselves, their families, and congregations through the Christmas season.

Advent Conspiracy is about the entire body of Christ at work in the world. As we worship fully, spend less, give more, and love all, something begins to happen that is greater than any single person, church, or denomination. As the Church, we are telling the story of Jesus to the watching world.

In truth, I have been practicing and promoting the "Advent Conspiracy" throughout my ministry, no matter where it happens to be taking place at the time. When I came across this "movement" a couple of months ago, it gave a name and focus to my own efforts. And this season, I invite all of you to join in the movement right here in Melbourne Beach, Florida!

This annual advent brochure is filled with many opportunities to practice the Advent Conspiracy—to live the season of Advent more deeply so that we might celebrate the Incarnation, the Nativity of Our Lord Jesus Christ with even more joy, enthusiasm and commitment to its meaning for our world and for each of us.

I invite you to "conspire" with me, and I look forward to seeing many of you throughout these Advent weeks, as we commit ourselves to worshipping with more gusto, spending less and giving more—but most importantly—to widening the expanse of our love!
